
Pooley meanwhile headed up to the graveyard for his nocturnal activities and was sorely disappointed that the checkback was just before the graves.

From here, what happened will remain a mystery, as your Scribe buggered off back to the start to catch the front runners at this point, so has no idea where the trail went.




