

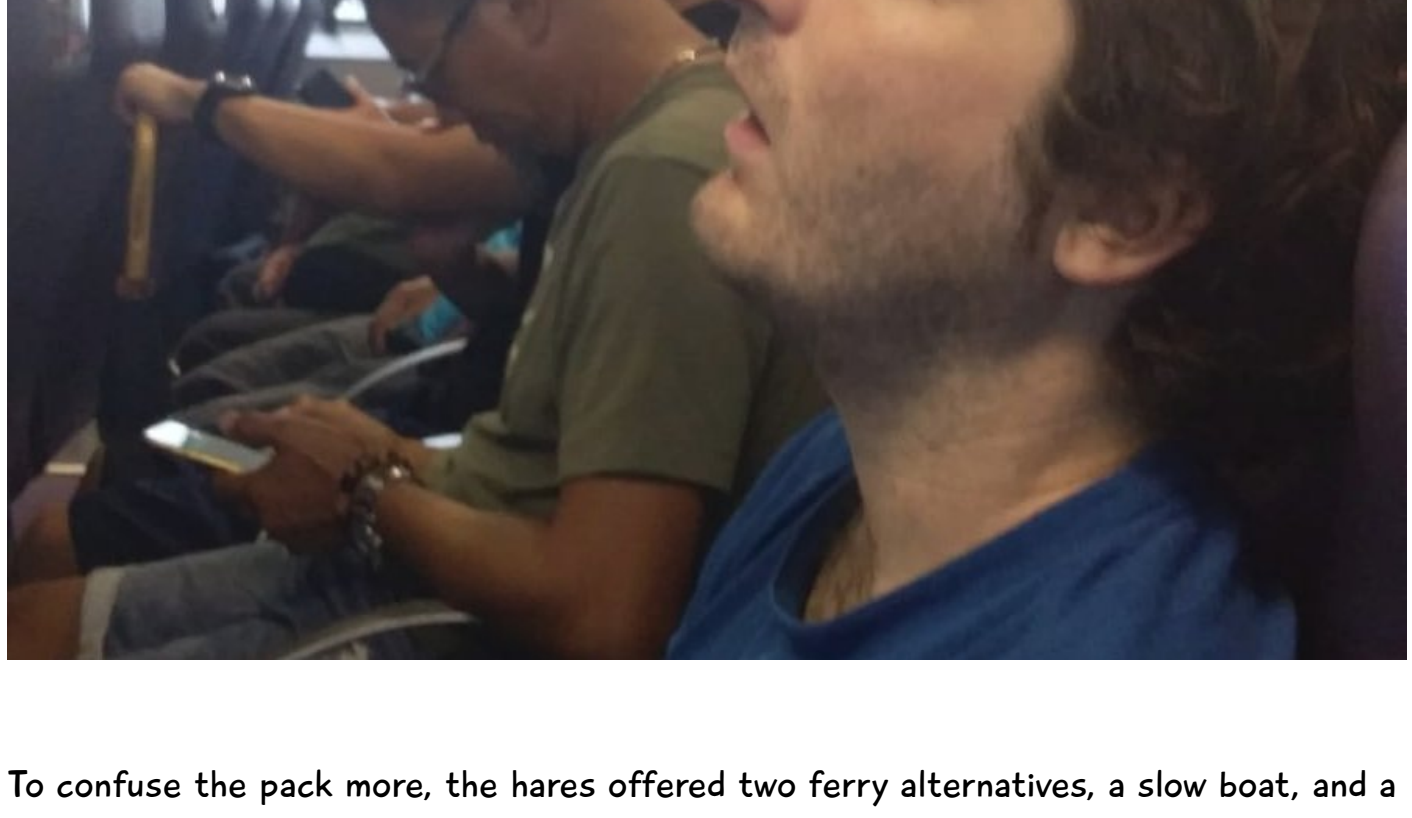
H4 The First and Most Ancient Hash in Hong Kong 1970 -2019

Writeup Run: 2619 – The Cheung Chau Classic

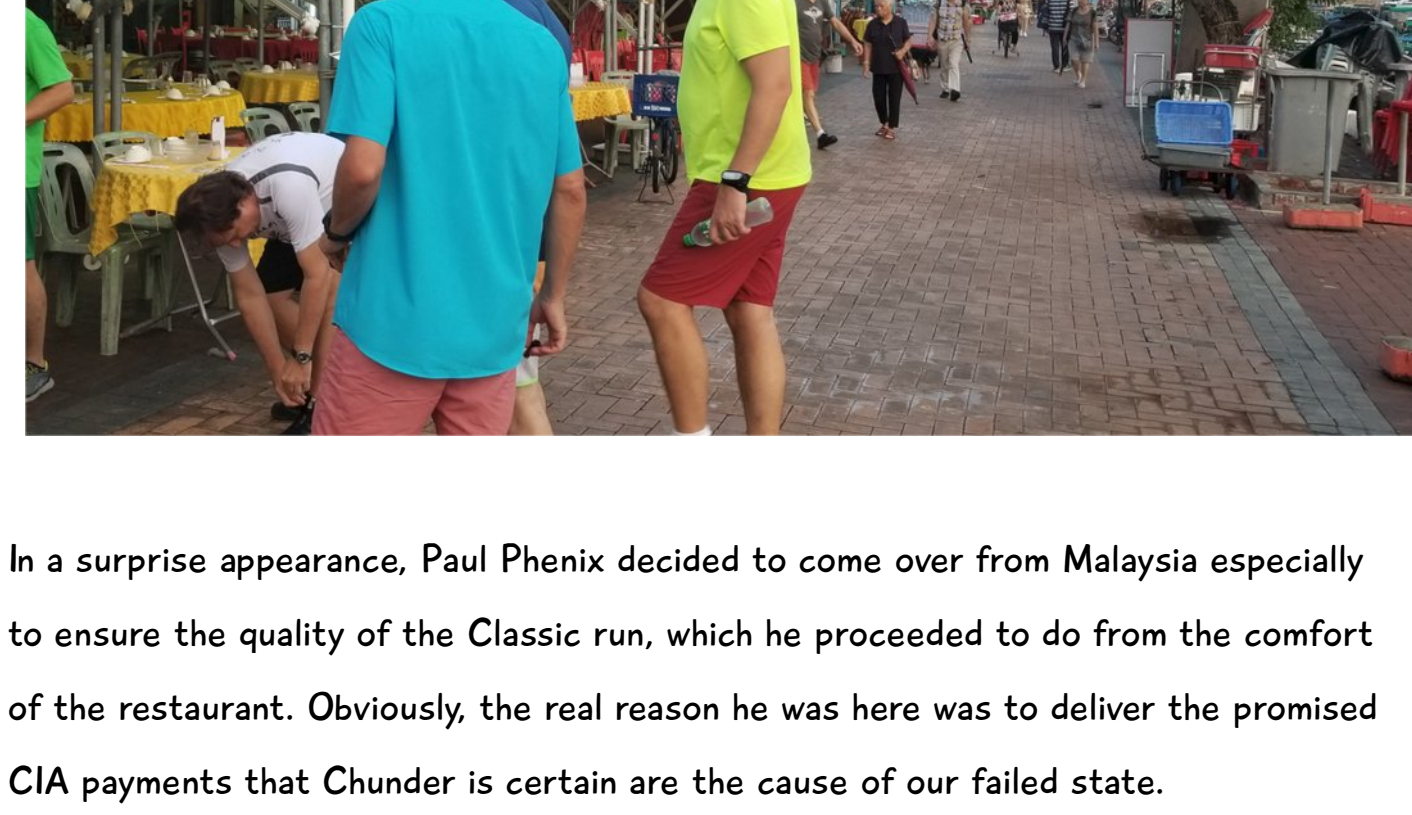

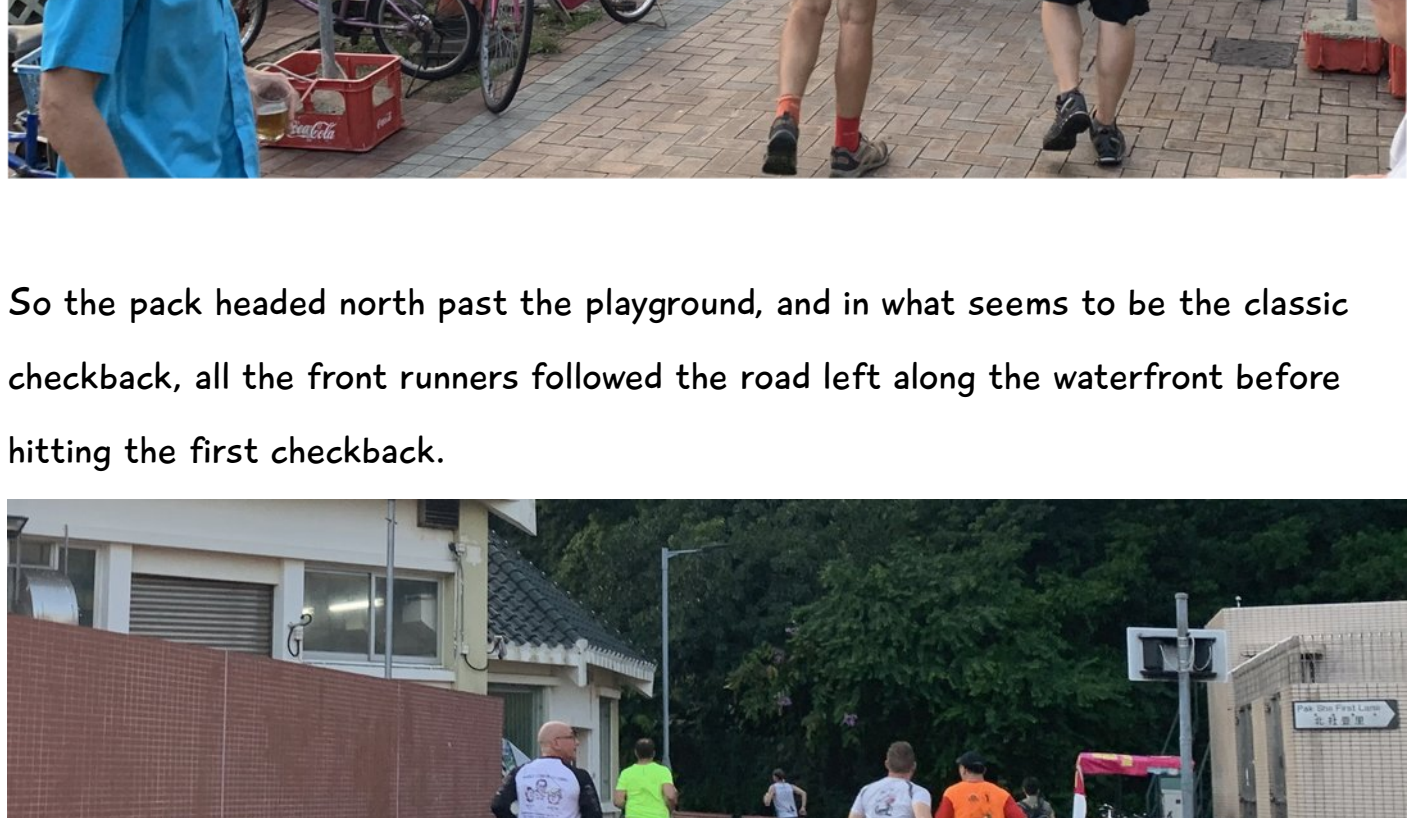
The GM still recovering from his trip away, took it easy on the way over, ensuring better quality Down Down's this week.

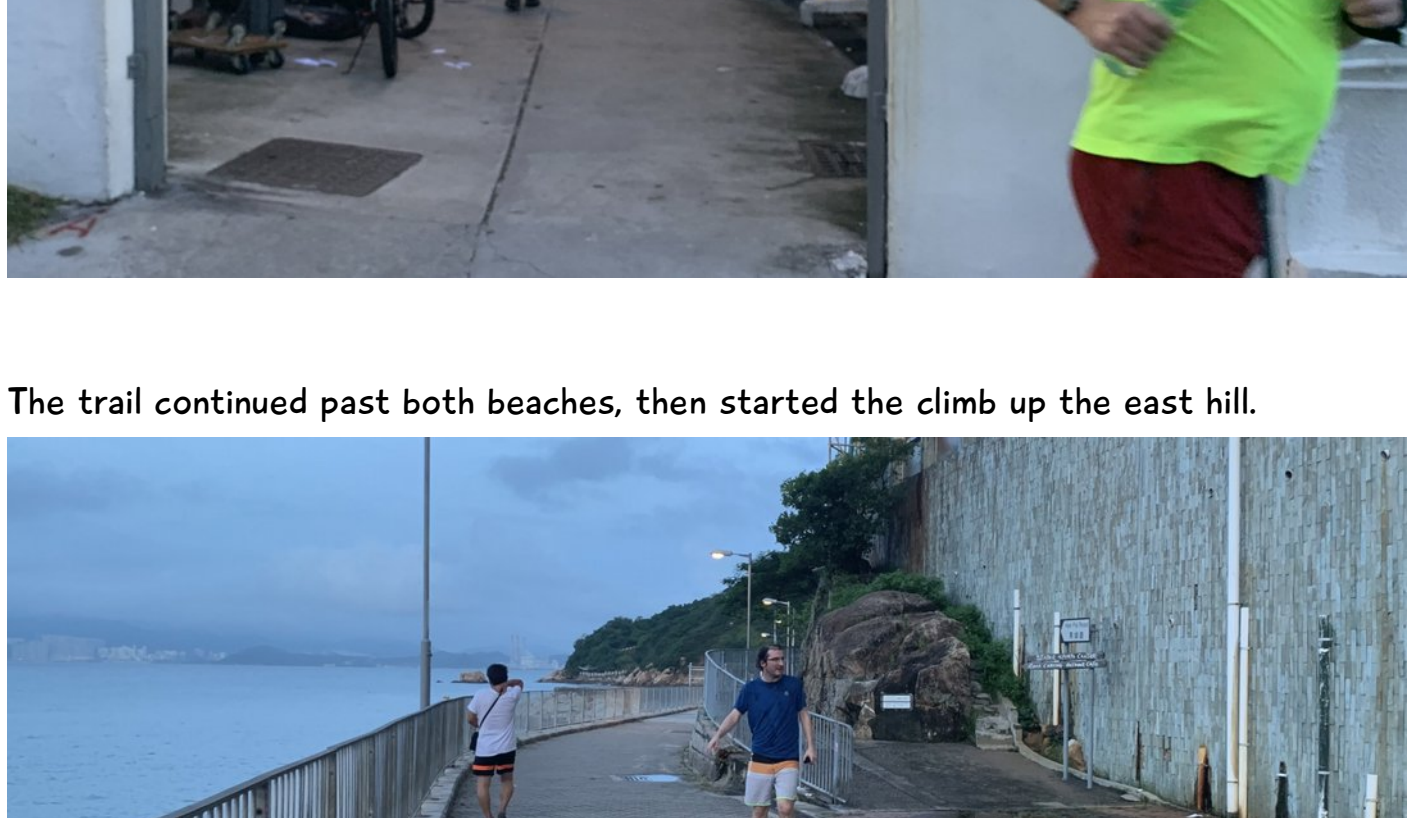

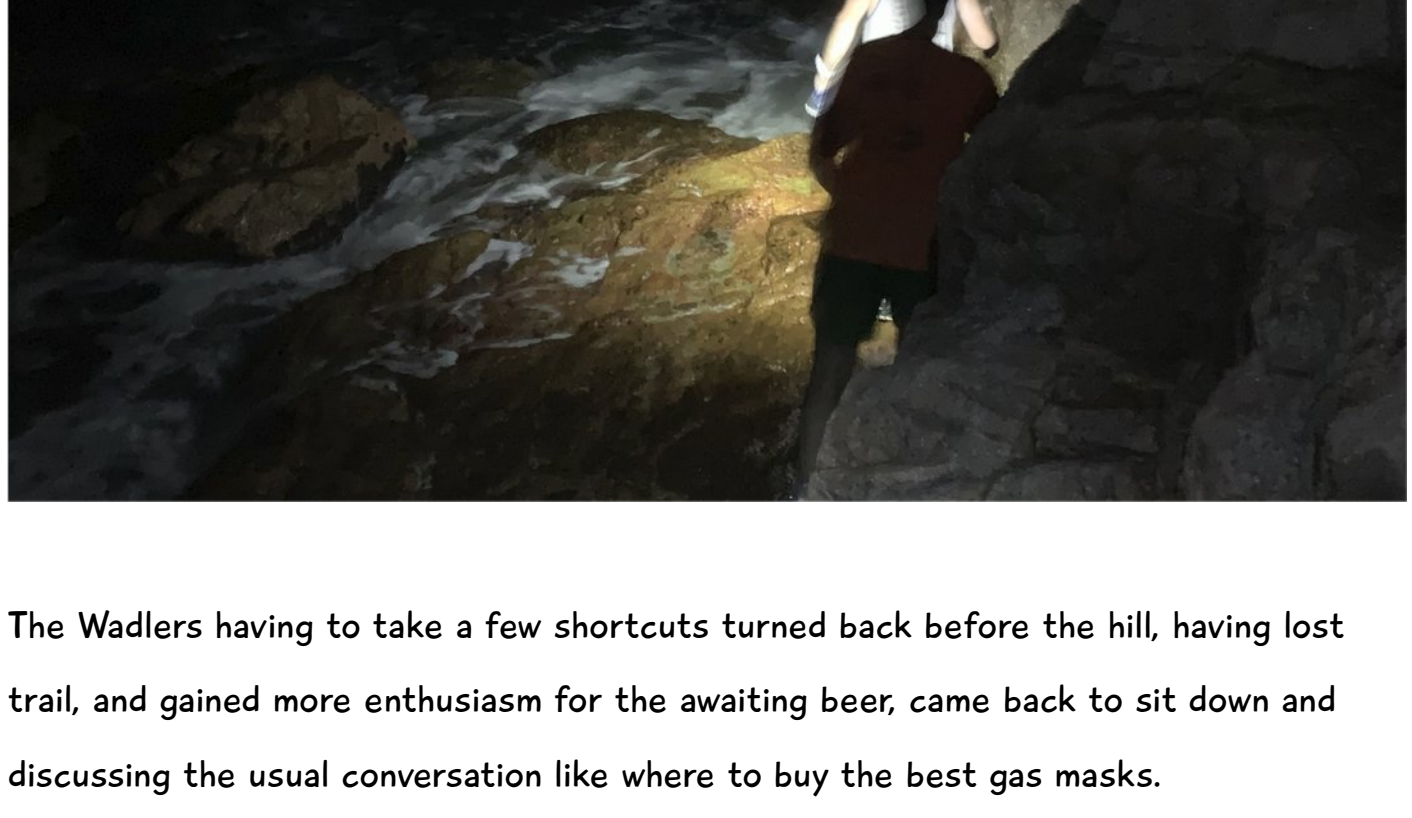

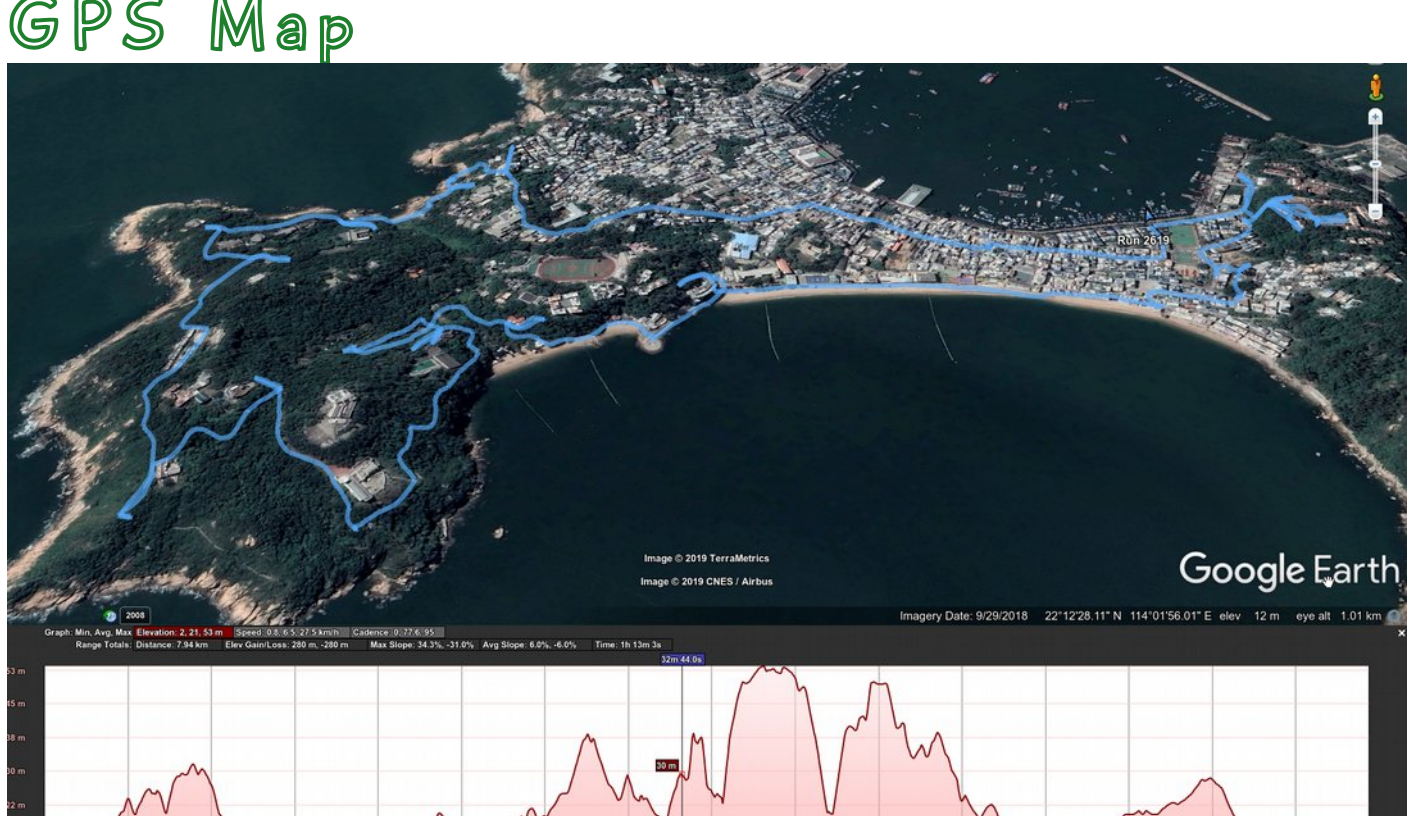
So the pack headed north past the playground, and in what seems to be the classic checkback, all the front runners followed the road left along the waterfront before hitting the first checkback.



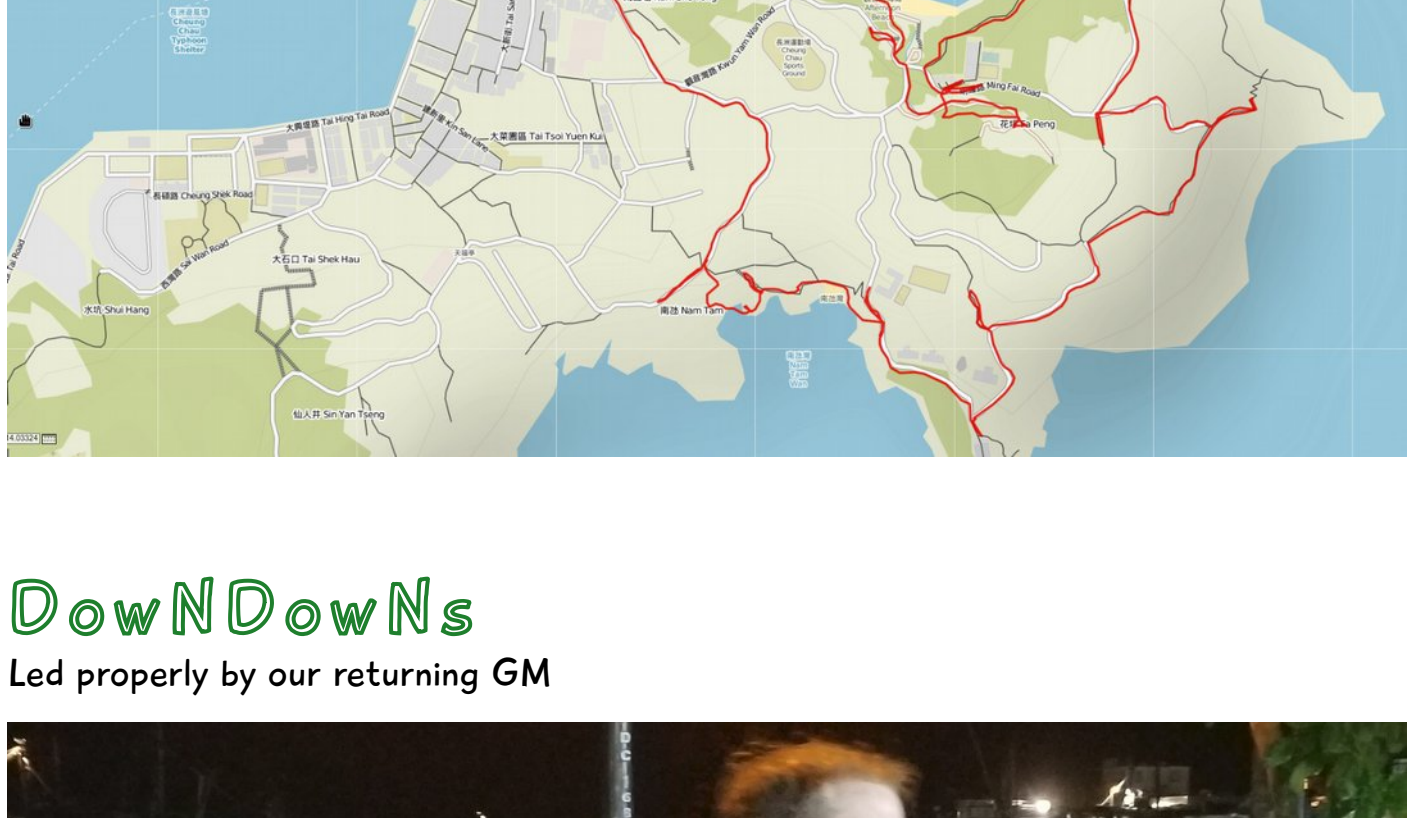

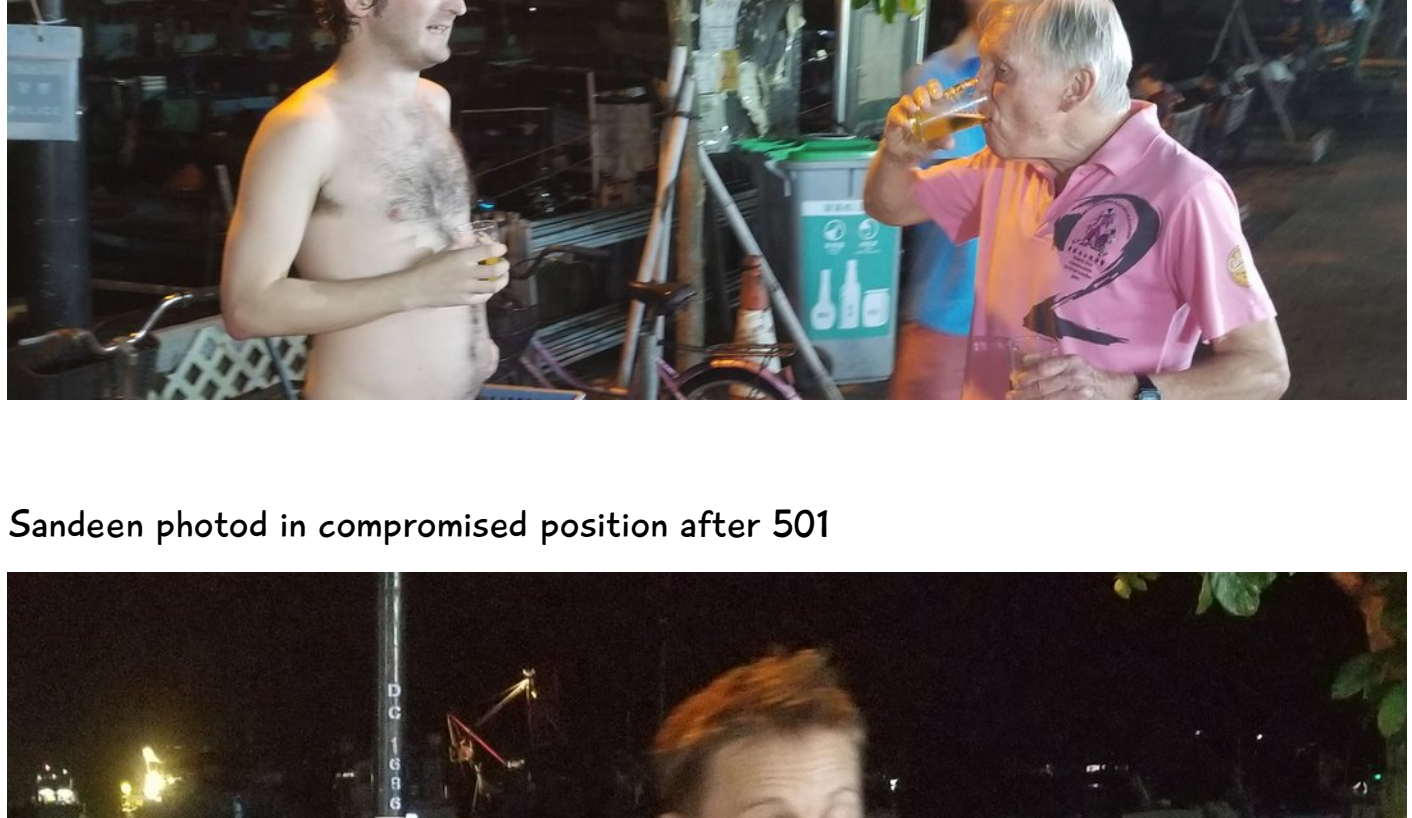

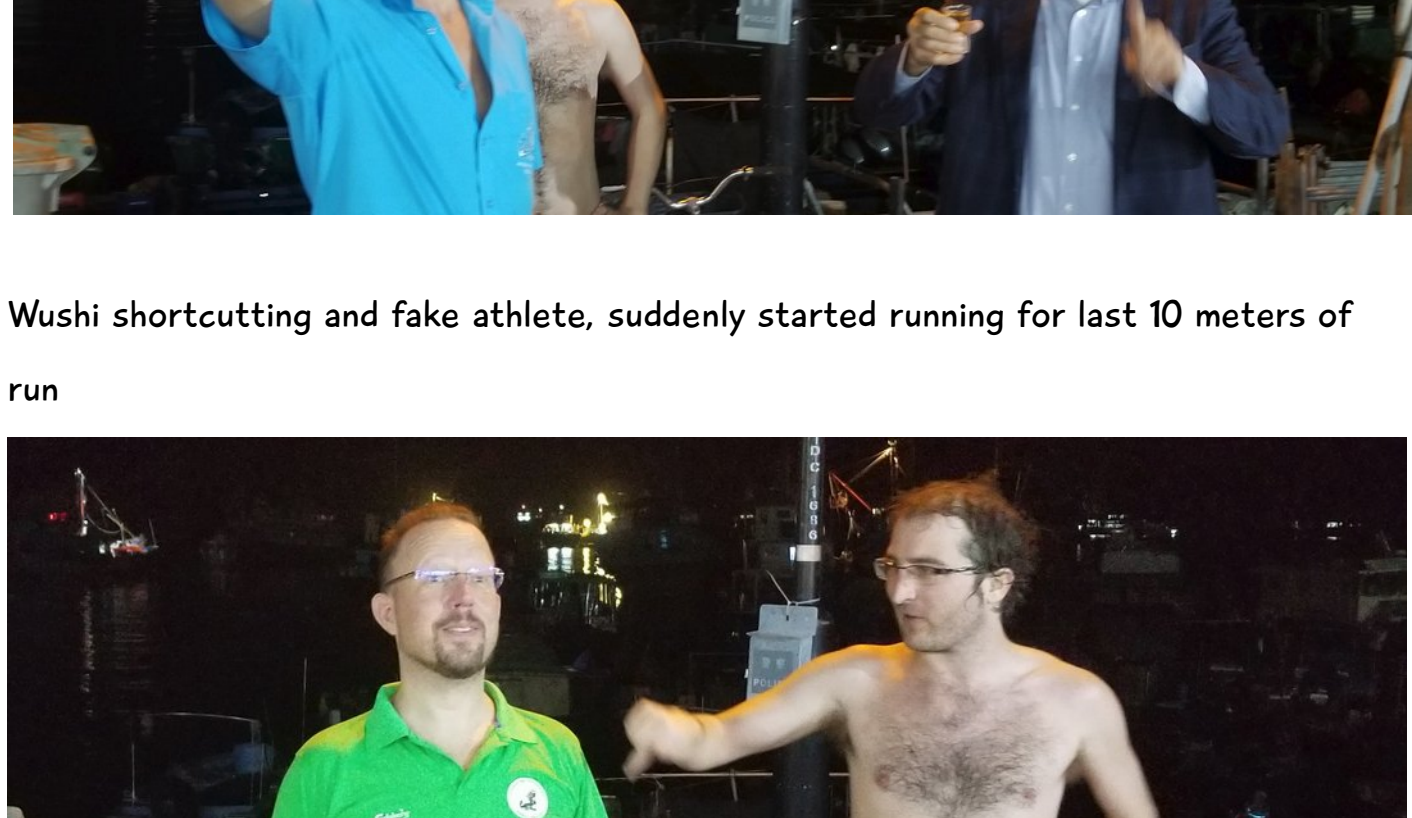
The trail continued past both beaches, then started the climb up the east hill.

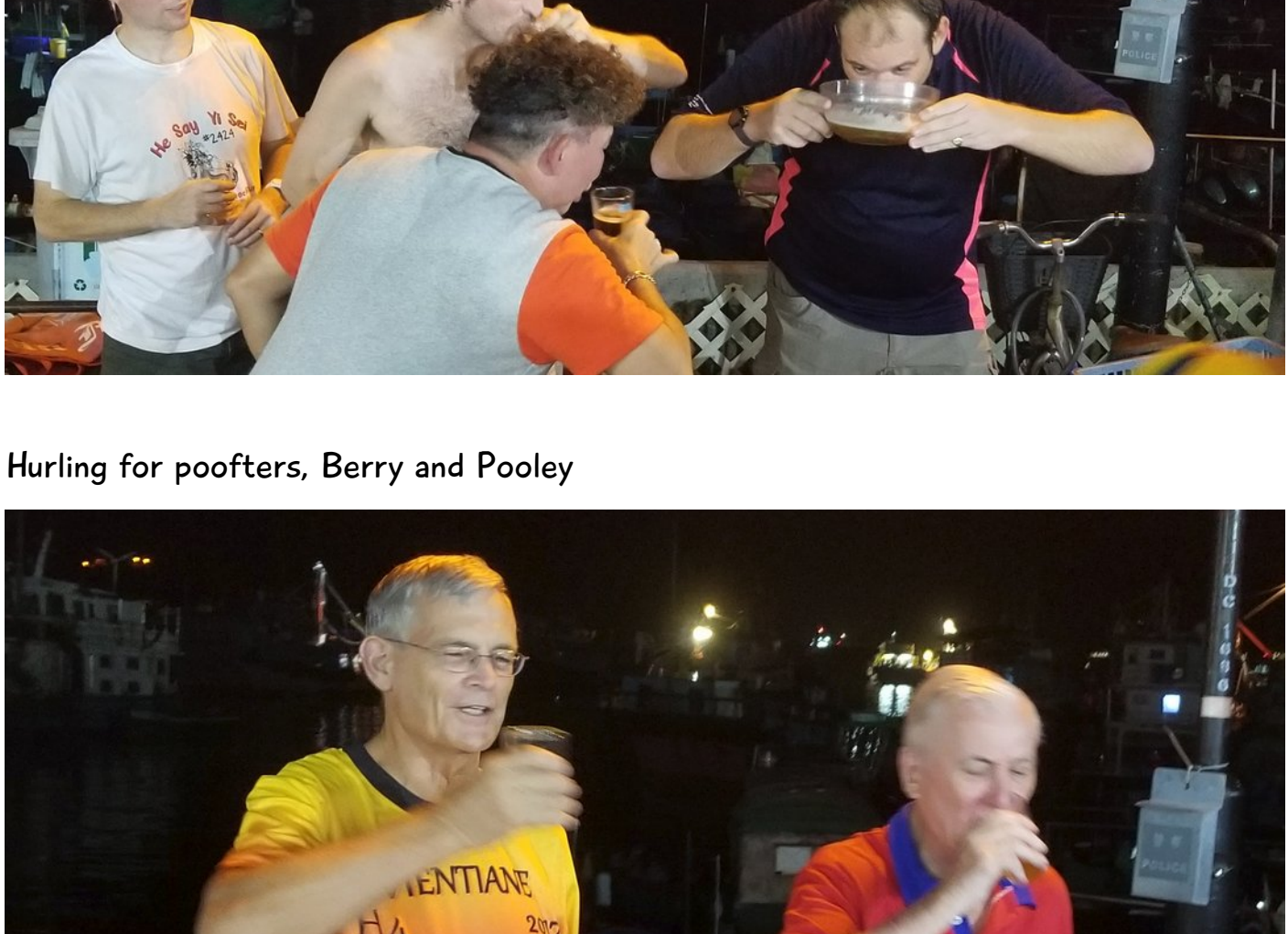


Shortly after they arrived, a rather exhausted looking Pooley turned up, having done the whole run, and not really needing the head start that he got.

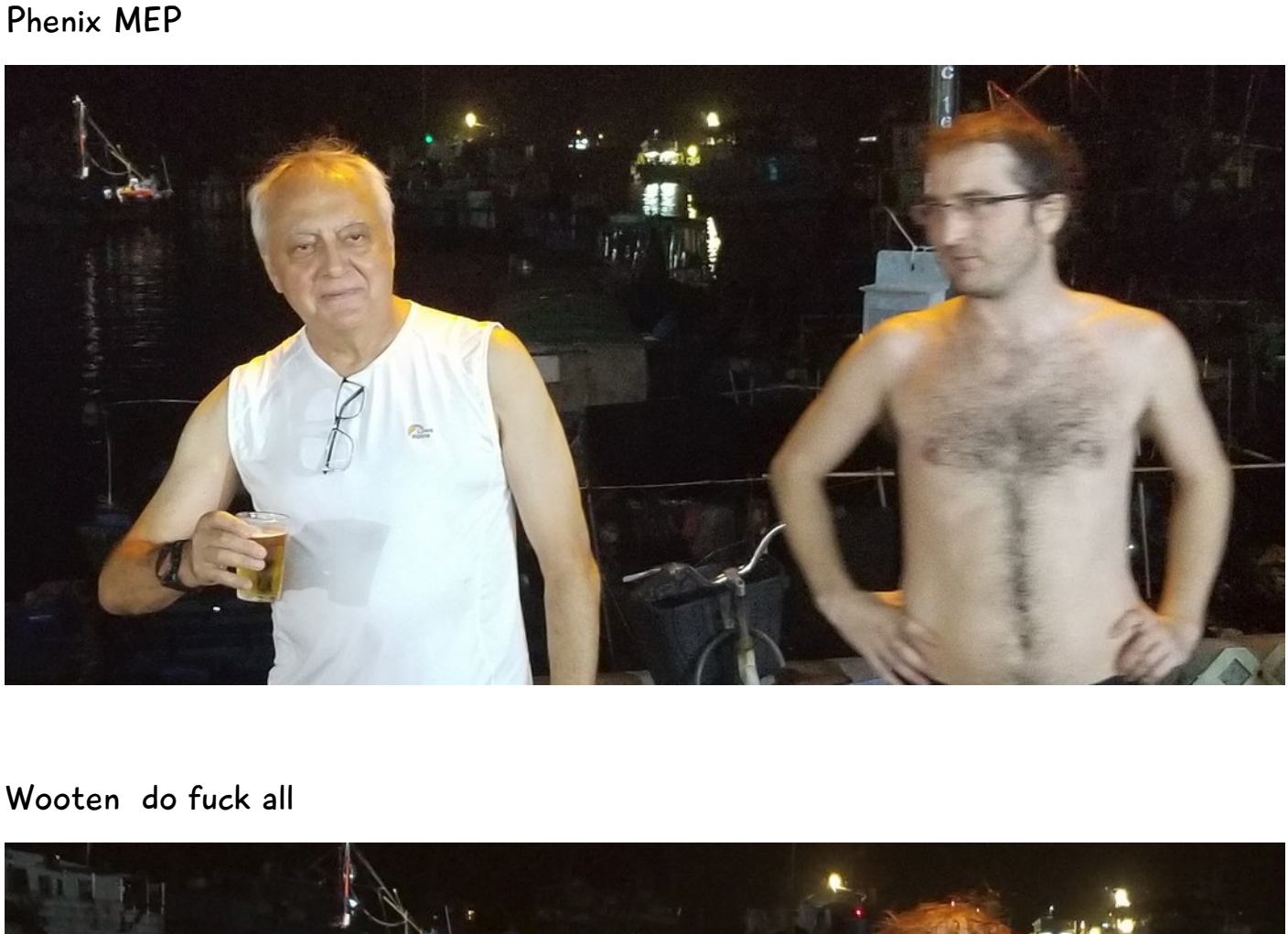


From then on a steady stream of runners appeared in various states, oddly enough a few looked a bit to dry and might have found a massage parlour somewhere on the island.
