
So in yet another quiet week in the failed state, the temperature finally dropped from sweaty and nasty to cool and pleasant. Also returning us to the dark night down-downs.


The bus made it's way to the run site, not without a few misgivings as someone mentioned that 'A' was actually on a closed road.









The trail led along the catchwater, where after a single check it got to the Rambo's Walkers split.






Wushi managing to spend most of the time reminding the GM, that he knew where it was going,




but would not tell.. over and over again.

Further up the trail was another 100m, which thankfully was not to be climbed,




instead, the trail led along quite a wide path down the hill back towards the catchwater.




For the wadlers having skipped the climb, reached the rejoin of trails after a brisk 15-minute walk and rather than attempting any kind of accent decided to continue along the path.


Hash splittest - Thane and Paolo joining 'another hash' last friday, Thane even giving away his shoes to some vagrant attending

Rugby World Cup - Denmark beat Mexico – Steffen




Do fuck all award Chris Simpson (proceeded to spend rest of night in a frenzy and finished his TM duties by filling the calendar


