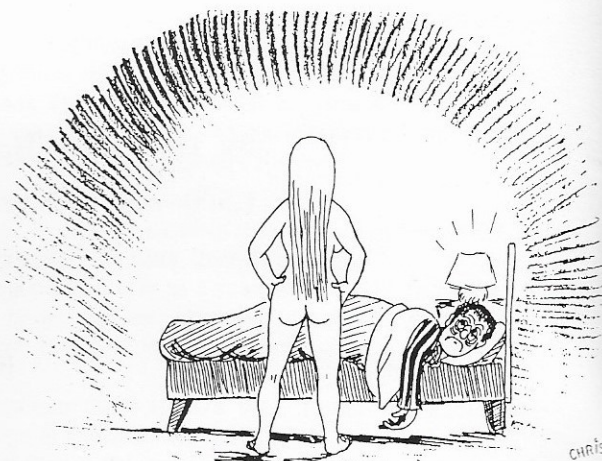

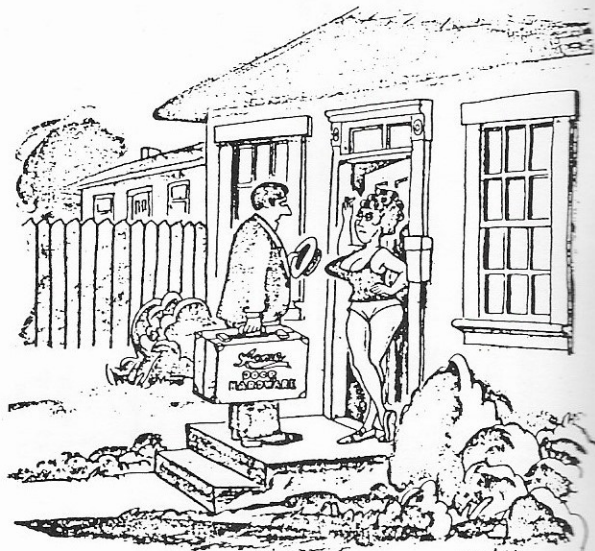

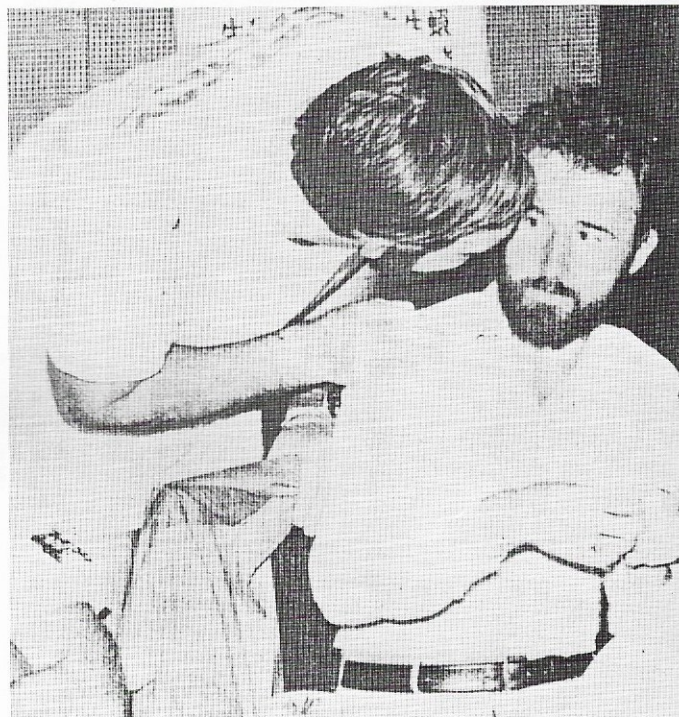

At last the trail was found, which led to high ground, with Jack the Fire giving us usual useless advice which the pack listened resulting in the whole bloody lot following a false trail.

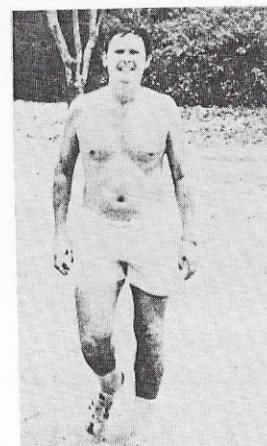
