

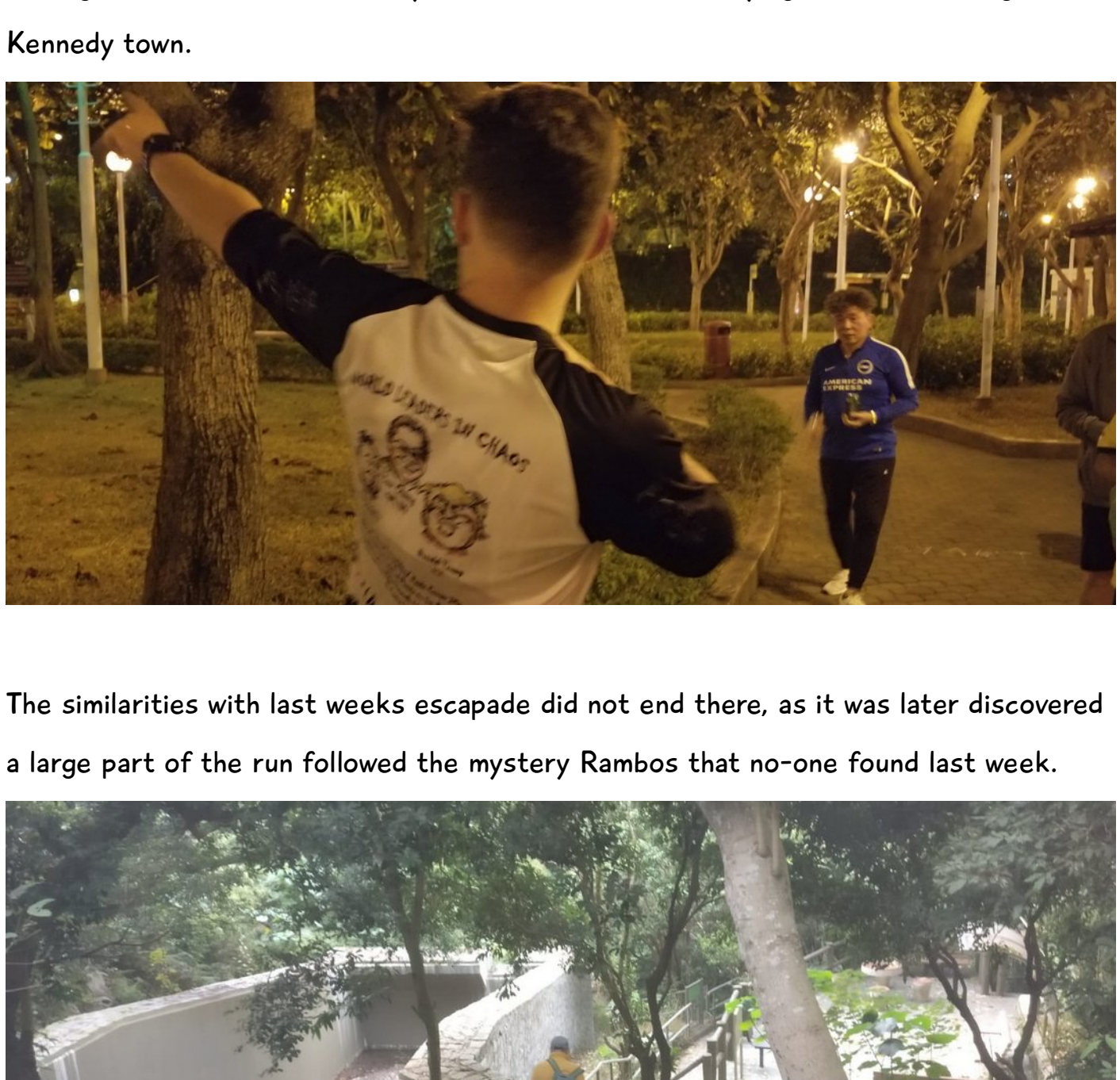
The First and Most Ancient Hash in Hong Kong 1970 -2019

Writeup Run: 2636 – Santa Seymour’s Kennedy Town Extravaganza

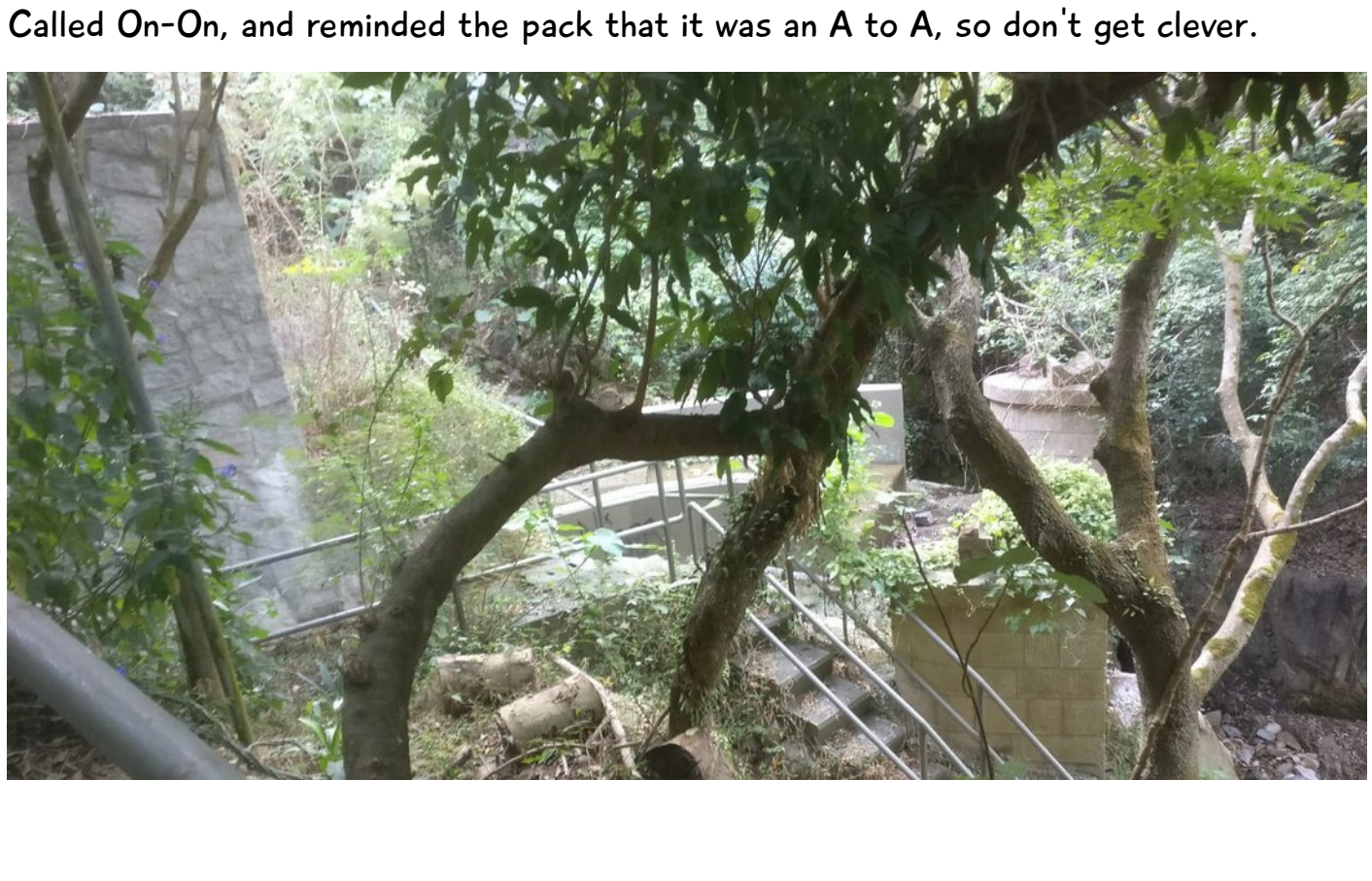

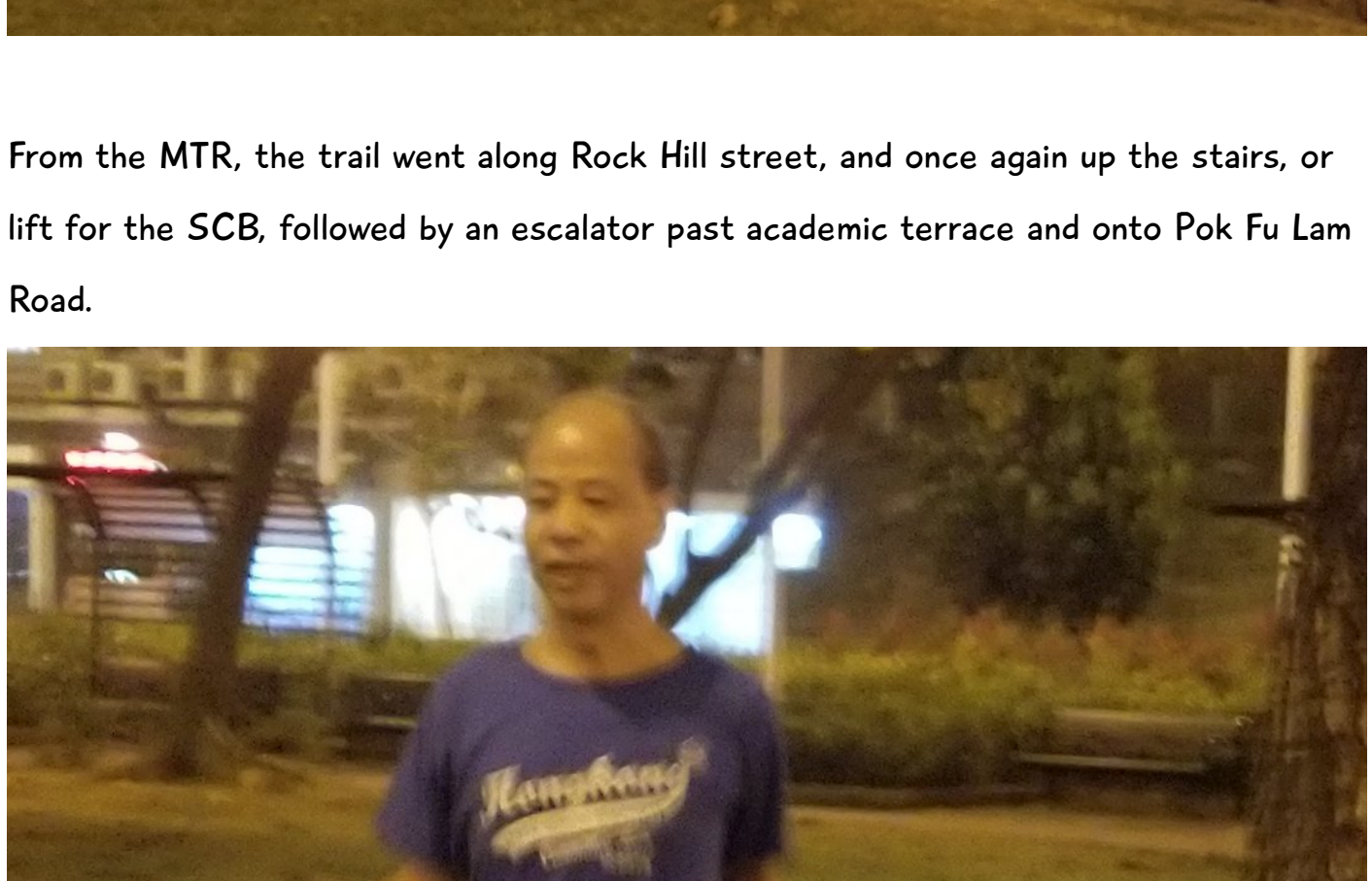
The similarities with last weeks escapade did not end there, as it was later discovered a large part of the run followed the mystery Rambos that no-one found last week.

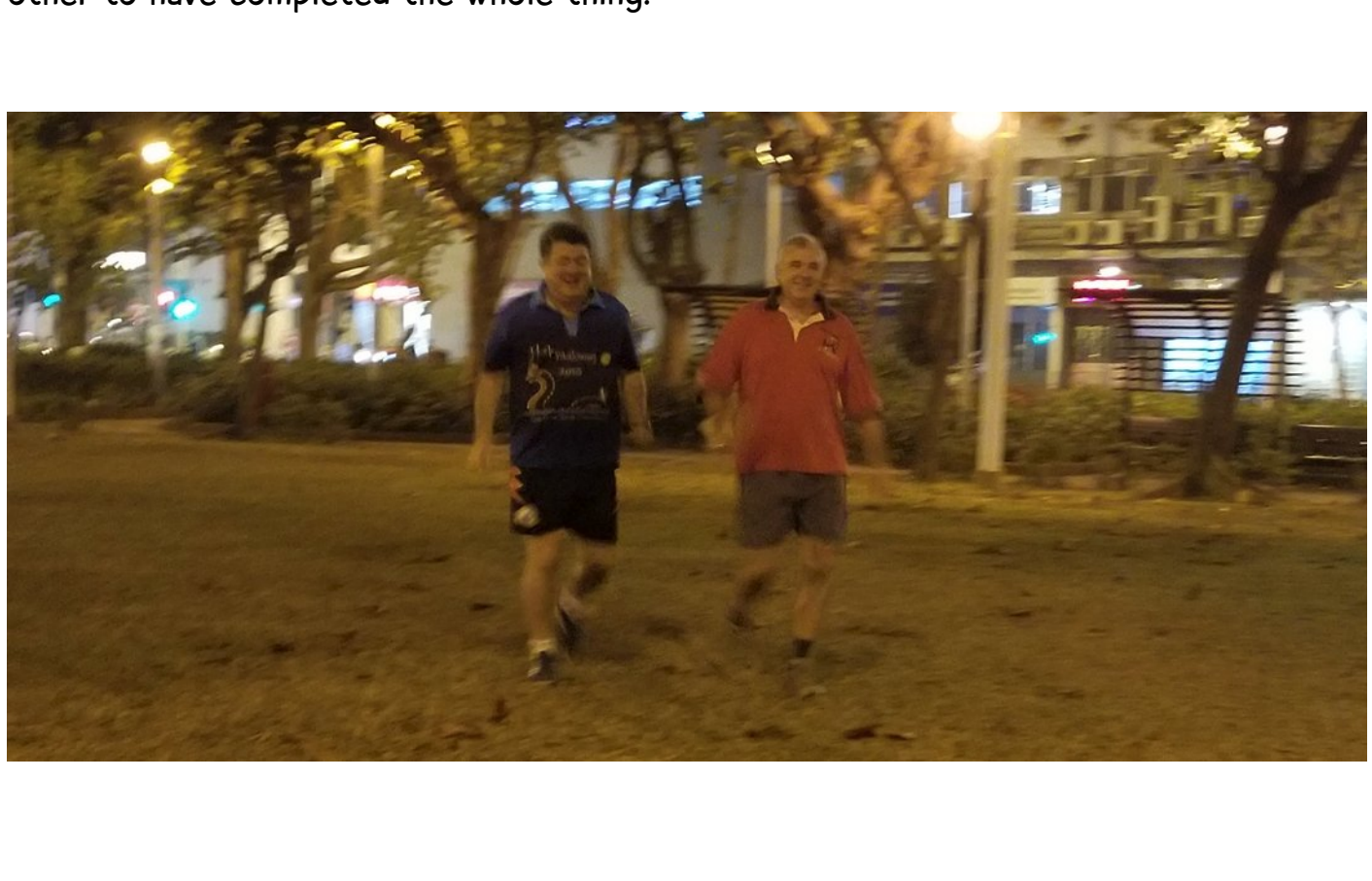

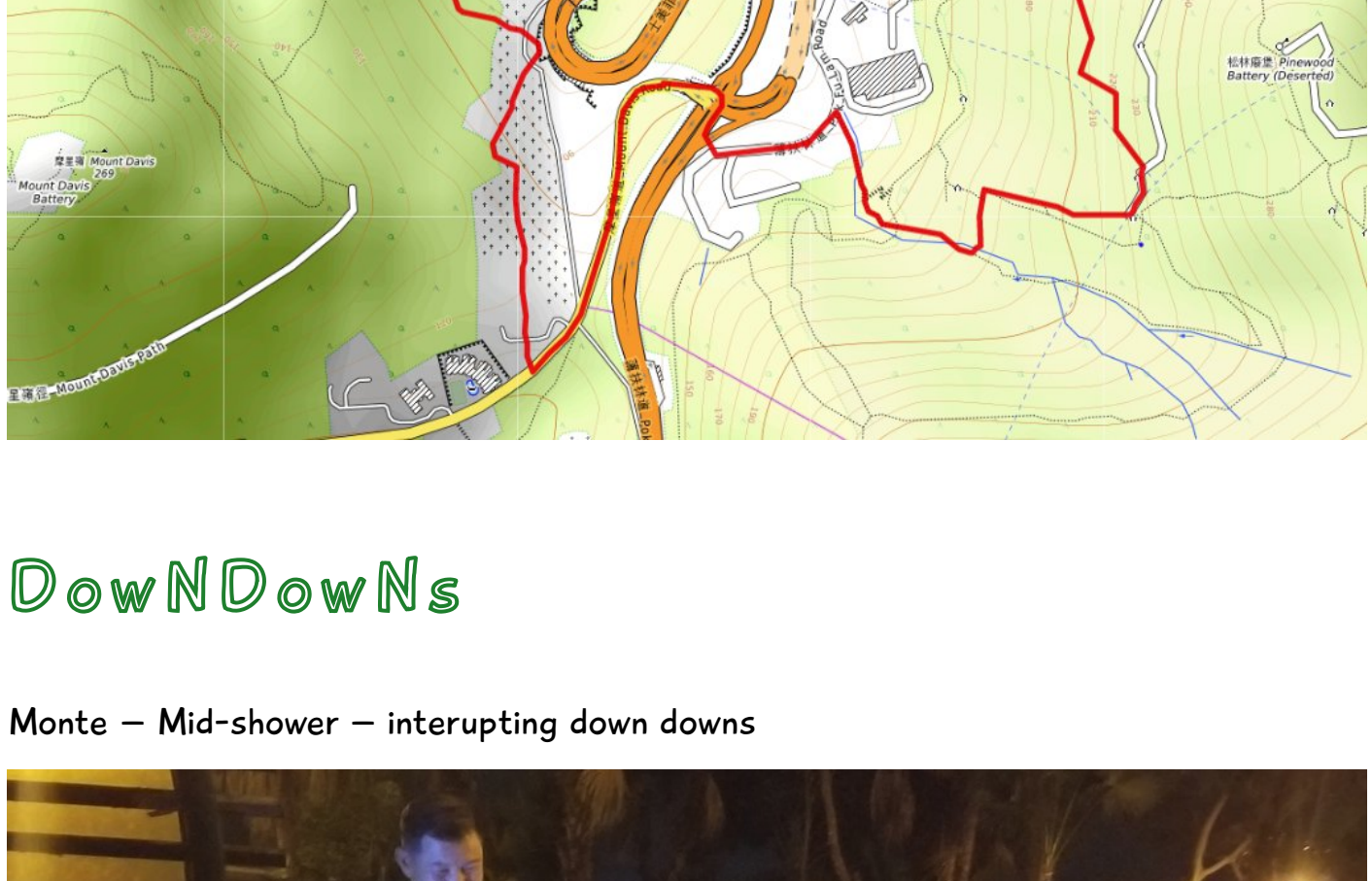
Having seen most of the pack go through, some 10 minutes later, Johan followed by Sandeens son and Nephew came running back through the park looking for trail.

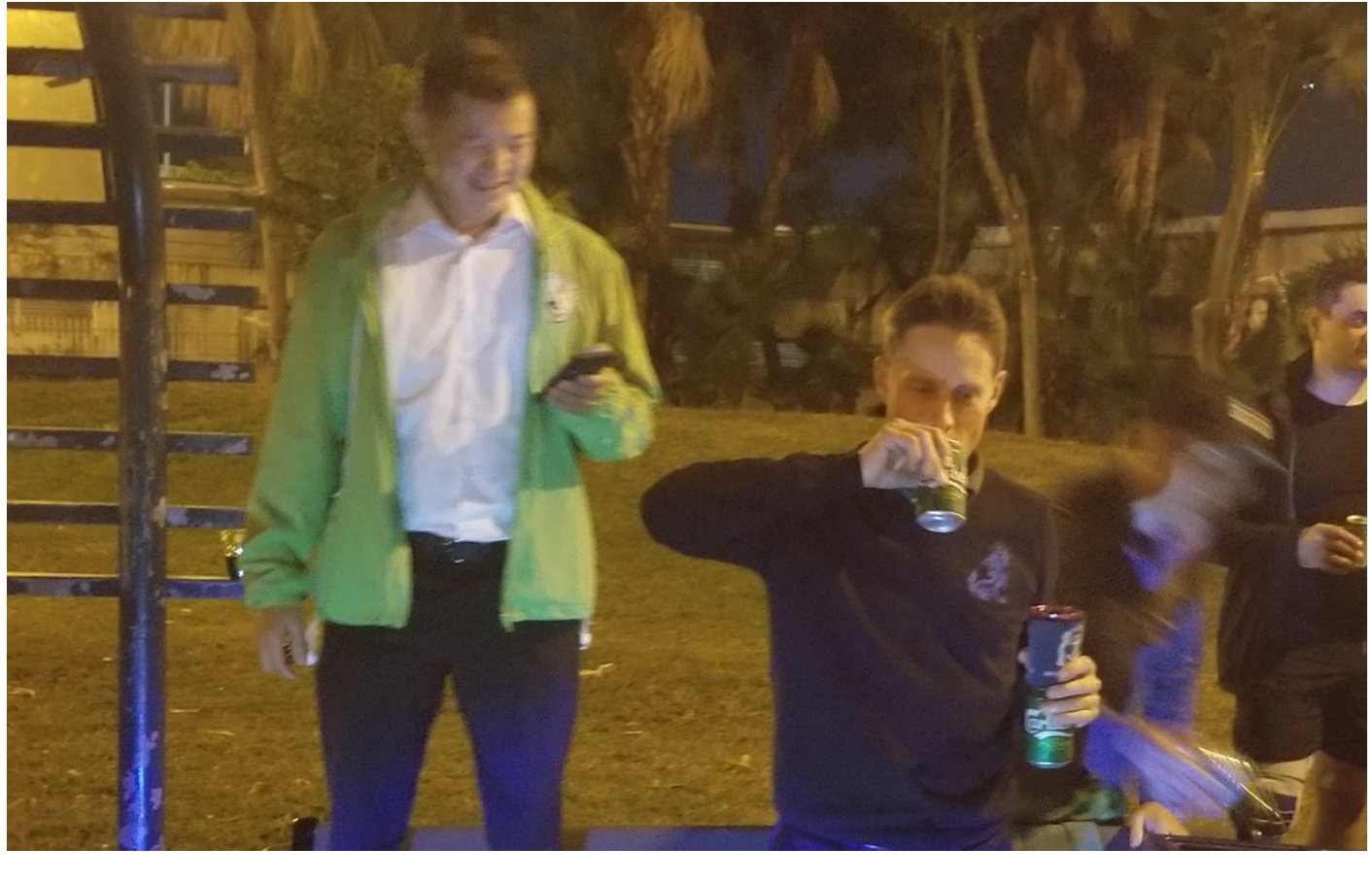


From there past the cemetery and down back towards the MTR and on Home. With any luck, we can all run a small variation of the same trail next week as well.

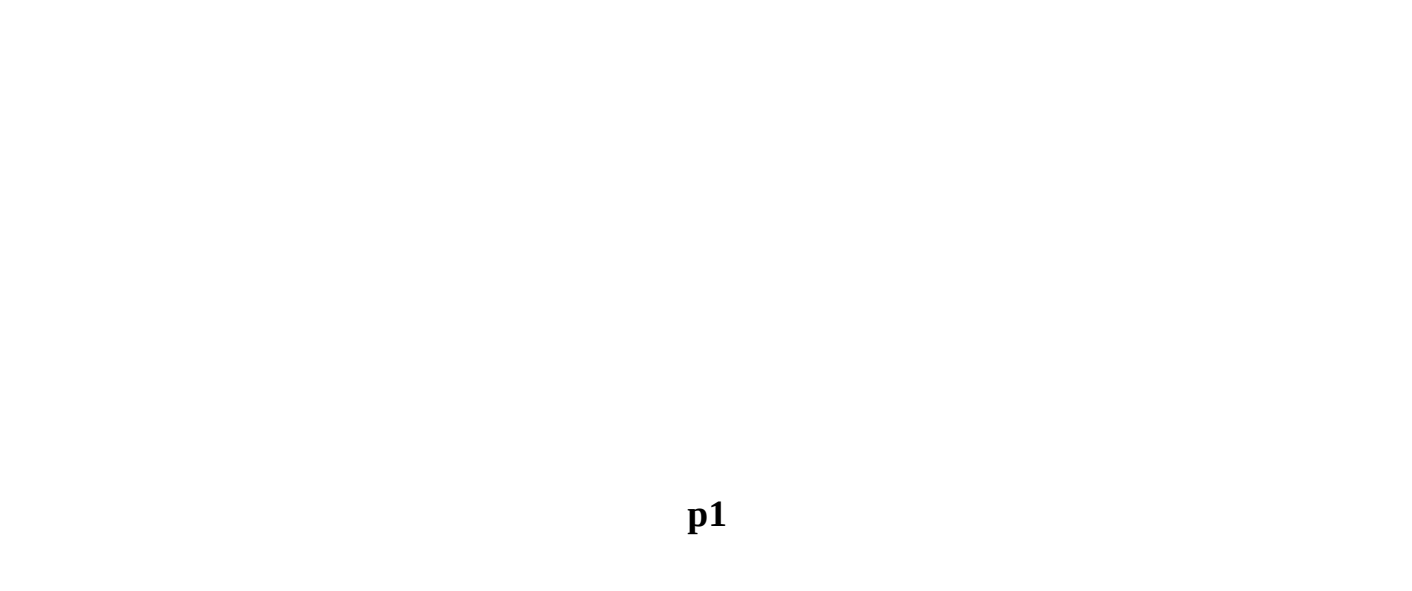
First back were Simpson Jnr and Breechan Jnr, one claiming to have lost trail, the other to have completed the whole thing.

Brechan junior & Simpson junior unreasonably fast finished the run, suspected of SCB



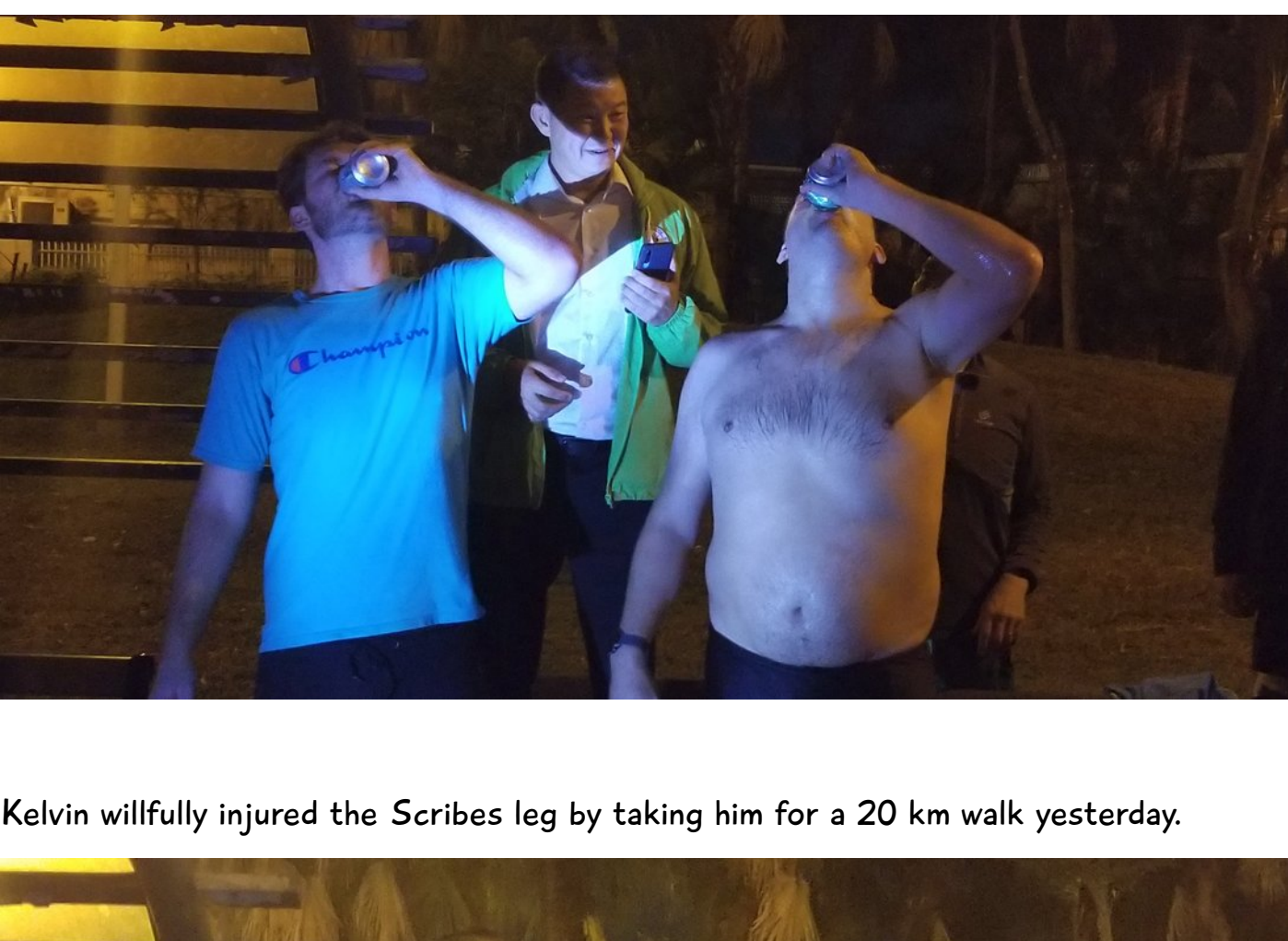

Disgraceful Willi Wu wore a tear off hash T shirt to the run.



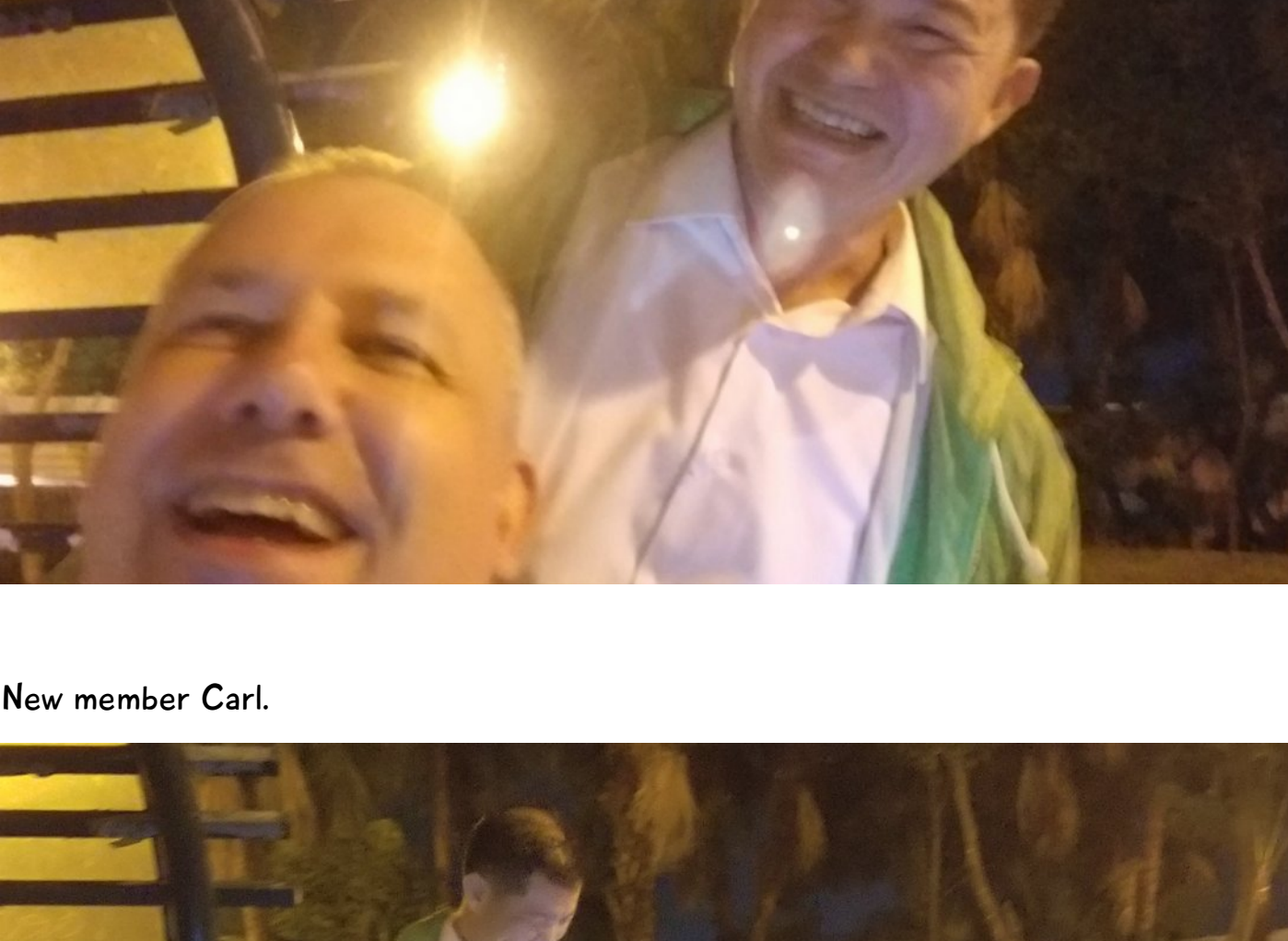
A faithful police supporter, Rene was dressed in a police T- shirt, but failed to advise guys not to urinate in the park.



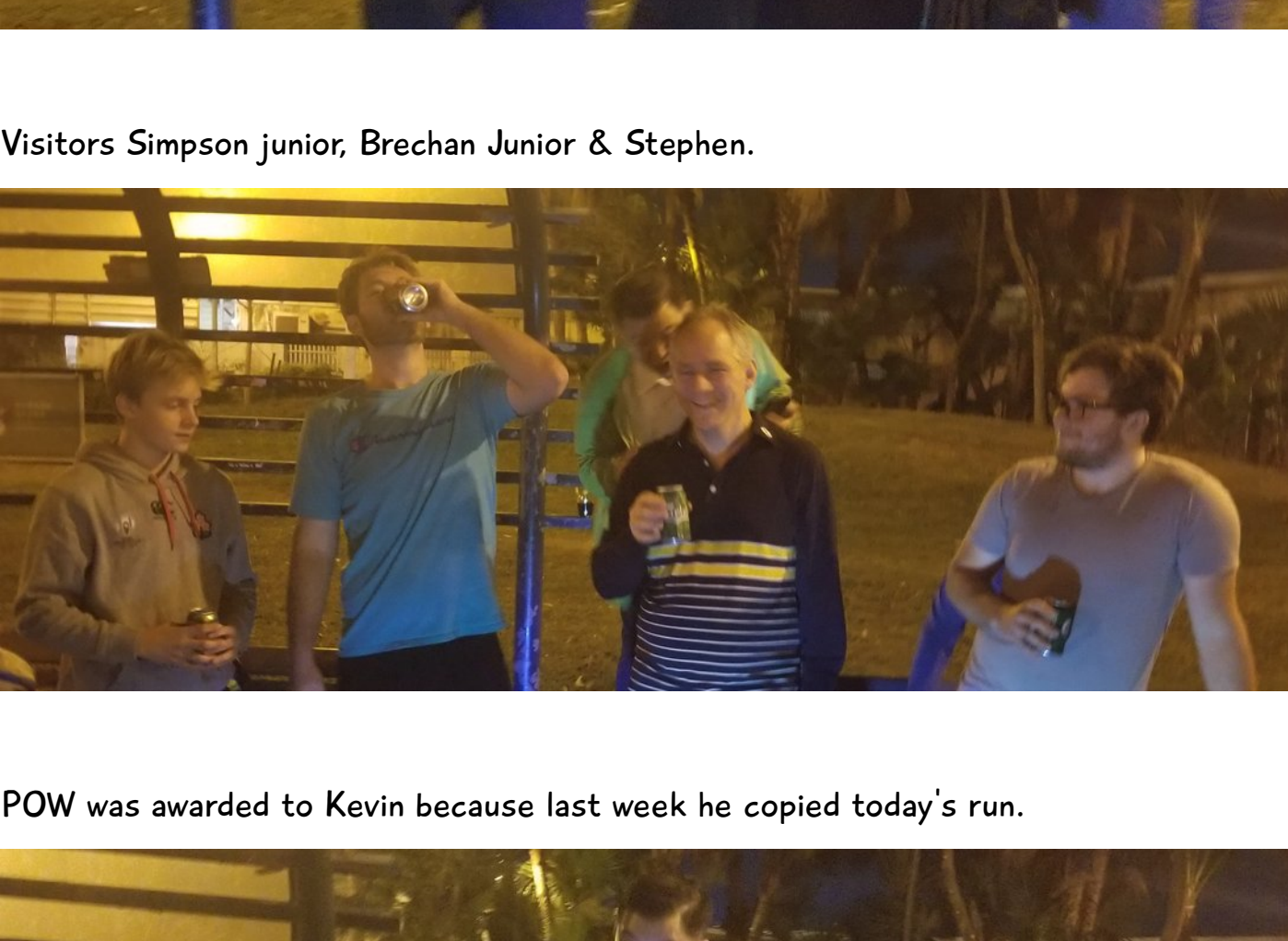
Our drinking champion, Monte was a slower drinker than a new gun, Sandeen's cousin, Joseph.



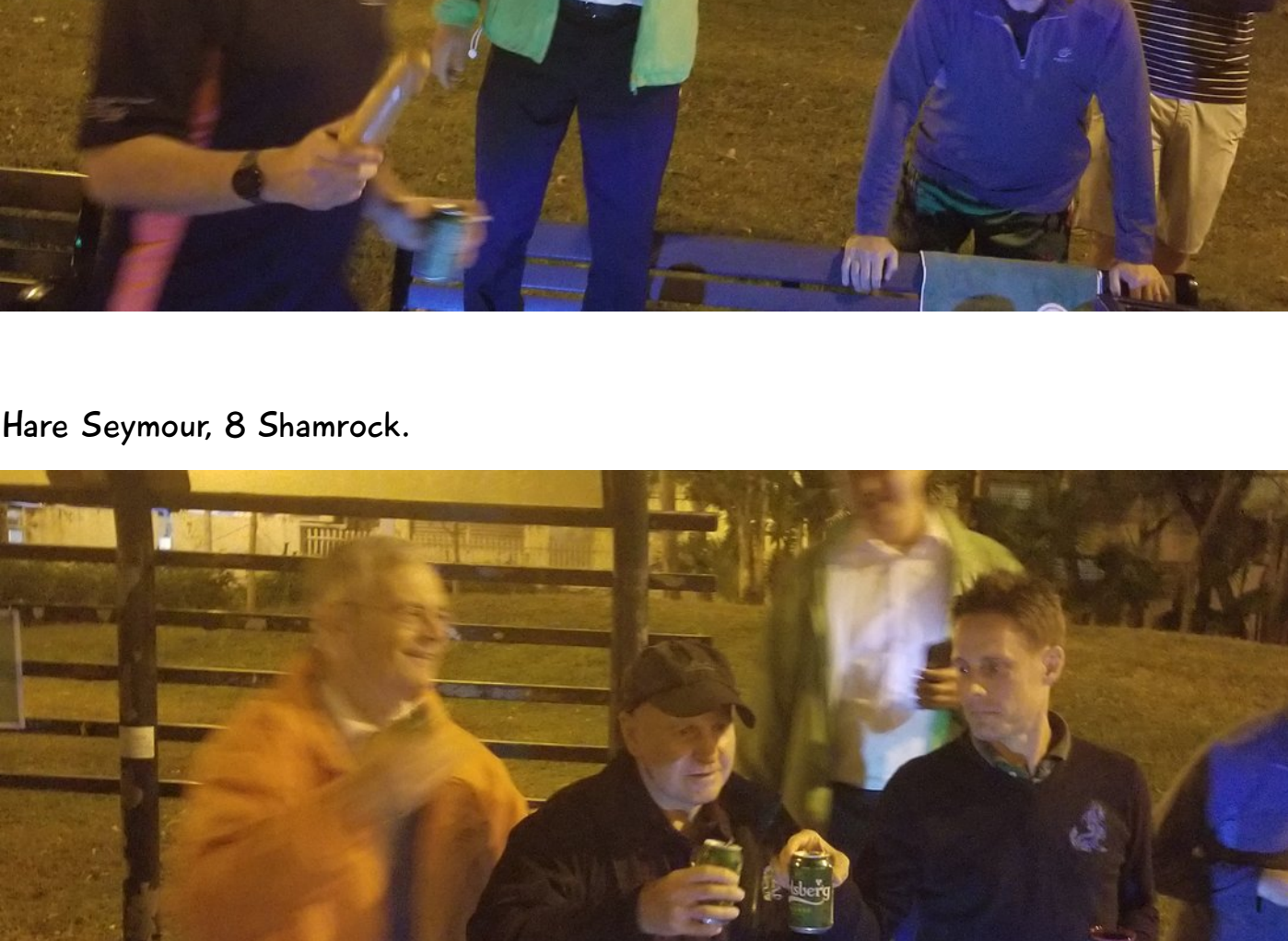
Kelvin willfully injured the Scribes leg by taking him for a 20 km walk yesterday.

David Rainsford wearing full running gear, making fake news of running.



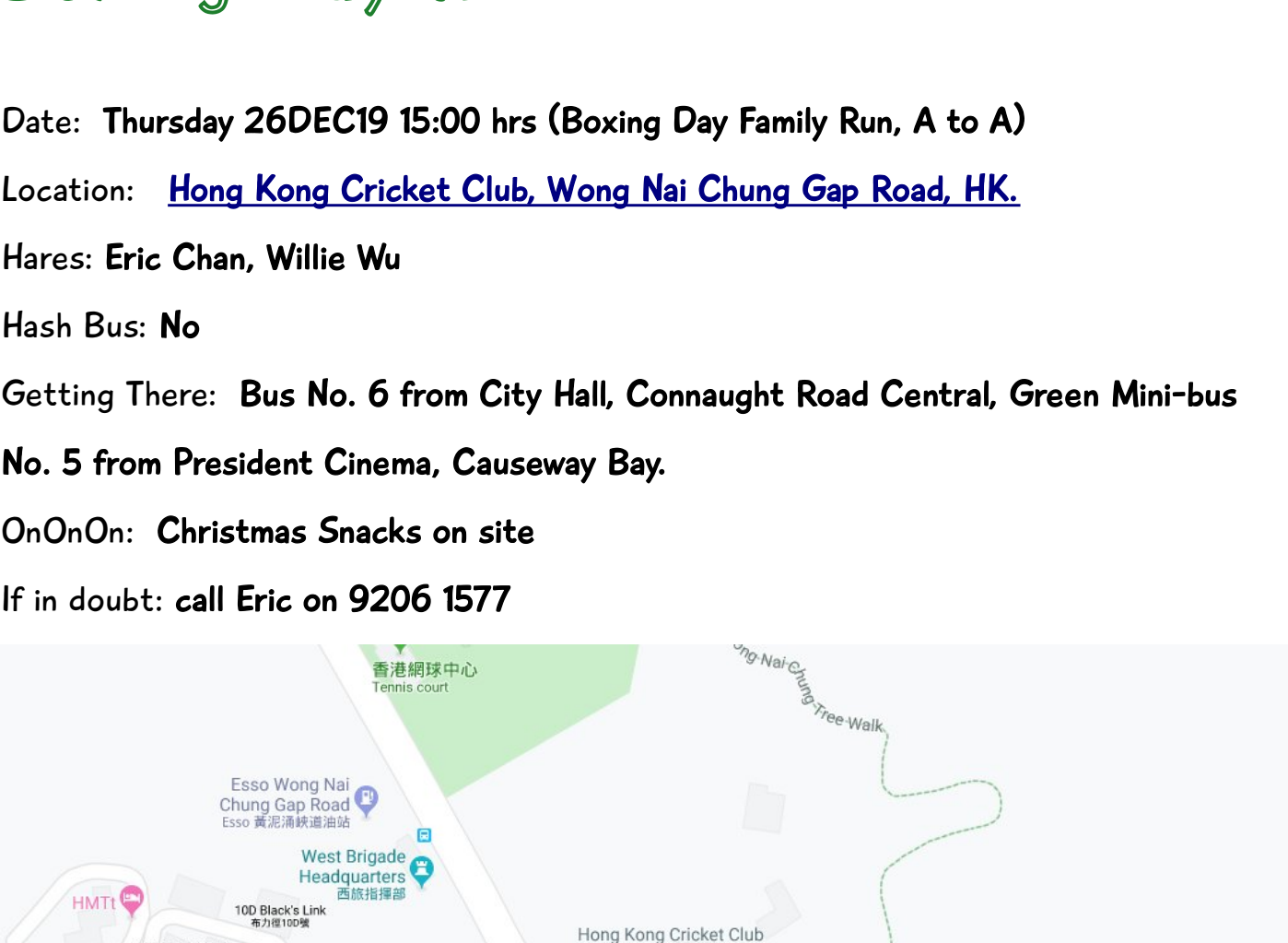

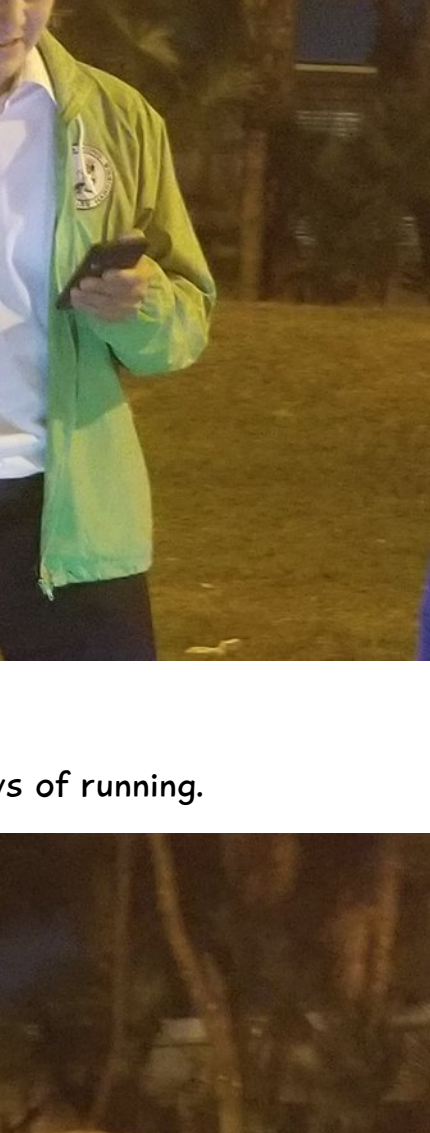
